



Cultural Access Pass Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us. This policy describes how we use the personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you register for a Cultural Access Pass. Personal information is information that is personally identifiable to you, such as residential address, telephone number and email address.

The personal information collected during the Cultural Access Pass registration process must come from (or on the consensual behalf of) eligible registrants. An eligible registrant is a person, 18 years of age or older, who has been sworn in as a Canadian citizen no more than one year prior to completing the Cultural Access Pass registration process.

Why Your Information Is Collected

The personal information collected in this form is for the purposes of administering the Institute for Canadian Citizenship's Cultural Access Pass program and regularly informing pass holders and former pass holders about special initiatives and offers and maintaining a professional relationship with pass holders and former pass holders.

How Your Information Is Used

The Institute for Canadian Citizenship uses your personal information to conduct surveys, send newsletters, updates about ICC programming, tours and special opportunities for pass holders. The Institute for Canadian Citizenship will never share, sell, or rent your personal information to a third party without your consent, except as required by law.

Retention of Your Information

All personal information entered in this registration form is stored securely. The Farm Inc. has been contracted to design the online registration process and tools in order to collect the requested information on a secured remote database. The information is collected via an online form which is protected by a secured certificate on a shared server leased to the Institute for Canadian Citizenship by I&I Internet, Inc.

When your personal information is no longer required for the purposes set out above (or for applicable statutory requirements), we will destroy or render your personal information non-identifiable (that is, alter the information so that it can't be associated with a specific individual).

How to Opt Out

Providing your personal information is required to register and participate in the Cultural Access Pass program. If you do not wish to provide this information to the ICC, please refrain from registering for the program.

If you do not wish to receive updates about ICC programming, tours and special opportunities for pass holders, uncheck the associated box during the registration process.

Access to Your Information

You are entitled to access, verify, amend and/or correct your personal information. We appreciate your assistance in keeping your personal information up to date and accurate.
